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### **1. CALAVERAS COUNTY PROFILE PRESENTATION**

Dave Haley, Calaveras County Economic Redevelopment agency provided Council with copies of the final Calaveras County Profile report. Copies of the Profile will be given to agencies and associations through the County. It will be updated every 3-5 years.

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2. **2011 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

The City Engineer provided the bid results for the 2011 street improvement project. The Council agreed that costs associated with the Roller Bypass project be considered before moving forward with awarding this project.

**Steve Difu** – 576 Sasa

Explained there were several areas in Greenhorn Creek where the roads were in need of repair. He asked if the City Engineer had considered the GHC Road Condition Report when selecting the current projects for street repair. The City Clerk explained when the roads in GHC were taken over for maintenance by the City, the Pavement Management Plan (2011 street improvement) was amended to incorporate GHC roads into that plan. The GHC Road Condition Report may reflect what needs to be repaired in GHC, but does not include all of the City roads and which may be in more need of repair.
