



## Attention

The City Council has imposed Phase II water use restrictions as we slowly recover from the long term drought. This is a cautionary action due to the estimated 60 percent of the state that still remains in a severe drought. We are asking all of our customers, including Commercial and Industrial Businesses, Residents and Schools, to continue to conserve water in any manner where you can comfortably conserve.

Please note that this restriction limits outdoor irrigation of landscaping (e.g., shrubbery, flowers, and plants not grown for human consumption) or lawn/turf. There is no restriction on plants grown for human consumption.

Everyone, including Commercial and Industrial Businesses, Residents and Schools must use the following watering schedule:

- If you have an **odd** numbered address you may water on **Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays**.
- If you have an **even** numbered address you may water on **Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays**.
- **No** watering is allowed on Mondays.
- Watering lawns, flowers, landscaping, ornamental plants and gardens between ten a.m. and six p.m. during this program is prohibited.
- Washing down sidewalks, driveways, parking areas, patios and other paved areas or buildings is prohibited.
- Washing any motor vehicle, trailer or moveable equipment may be done only with a bucket. A hose (See subsection (B)(5) below) shall be used for rinsing only.
- Use of a hose may only be used with a positive shutoff nozzle. (No Open Hoses).
- Allowing excess water to flow into a gutter or any drainage area for longer than three minutes is prohibited.

The state has also required some watering restrictions. Their restrictions are mostly similar to the City's restrictions except for the addition of the following:

- The use of potable water in a fountain or other decorative water feature, except where the water is part of a recirculating system.
- The application of potable water to outdoor landscapes during and within 48 hours after measurable rainfall.

**Phase II Watering Restrictions**

**B. Phase II -- Restricting use of Potable Water.**

1. Watering lawns, flower beds, landscaping ornamental plants or gardens is prohibited except on watering days as follows:
  - a. Odd-numbered addresses on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday;
  - b. Even-numbered addresses on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

(WATERING IS NOT ALLOWED ON MONDAYS)

2. Watering lawns, flowers, landscaping, ornamental plants and gardens between ten a.m. and six p.m. during this program is prohibited.
3. Washing down sidewalks, driveways, parking areas, patios and other paved areas or buildings is prohibited.
4. Washing any motor vehicle, trailer or moveable equipment may be done only with a bucket. A hose (See subsection (B)(5) below) shall be used for rinsing only.
5. Use of a hose may only be used with a positive shutoff nozzle. (No Open Hoses).
6. Allowing excess water to flow into a gutter or any drainage area for longer than three minutes is prohibited. (Ord. 351 (part), 1996)
