Duplexes or Accessory Dwelling Units	Meter Fee for 1 <sup>st</sup> unit, plus \$7,910 per additional unit
Granny Flat	Meter Fee for 1 <sup>st</sup> unit, plus \$3,515 per additional unit
Motels and Hotels	Meter Fee plus \$1,1000 per room or unit

Restaurants	Meter Fee plus \$22.00 per s.f. of seating area
Markets	Meter Fee plus \$2.20 per s.f. of floor area
Car Wash	Meter Fee plus \$220.00 per stall
Laundromats	Meter Fee plus \$220.00 per washer
All Others	Meter Fee plus (Fixture Units/30) x \$5,490.00
Landscaping Meters	No fee if the landscape plan meets all of the following criteria: A. Only authorized use is for irrigation of landscaping B. Not more than three (3) edible fruit or vegetable bearing plants within any 10,000 s.f. area without an approved plan of the Planning Commission or written approval of the Planning Department C. Landscaping must comply with all applicable ordinances.

Residential Unit	\$9,277.00 per unit
Hotel/Motel	\$6,958.00 per unit
Mobile Home	\$8,697 per space
Car Wash	\$11,596.00 plus \$386.00 per stall
Restaurant	\$9,277.00 plus \$115.00 per 100 s.f.
Laundromats	\$11,596.00 plus \$231.00 per washer
Commercial, Industrial, and other buildings	Proportionately rated to a 24-fixture unit residence following the Equivalent Fixture Unit Table in the current edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code with a minimum connection fee of \$6,958.00 <b>Connection Fee = (Fixture load x \$9,277)/24 or \$6,958.00, whichever is greater</b>
Commercial Industrial, and other buildings that may generate high waste volumes or impose high BOD loading	To be established by City Council, based on projected and BOD load.
