1. ALLIANCE FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION

Kristi Reesman of the Alliance for Substance Abuse Prevention (ASAP) provided a presentation to the Council on the dangers and the health issues related to smoking and second-hand smoke. Also speaking on the subject were Teens Against Tobacco and Dr. Kelaita, Calaveras Health Officer. The Group asked the Council to consider passing an ordinance regulating smoking within the City of Angels.

The Council said that staff will take this item under consideration. The City Administrator suggested that City staff and the City Attorney research the issue further including the cost for implementing such an ordinance and also contacting the County to find out where tobacco tax monies are spent. This item to be brought back to the Council for further discussion after further research by both ASAP and City Staff.
