2. **RE-INTRODUCE ORDINANCE NO. 478. AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 8.26 OF THE CITY OF ANGELS MUNICIPAL CODE REGULATING SMOKING WITHIN THE CITY OF ANGELS**

The City Attorney outlined the changes made to the ordinance at the request of Council. The Mayor asked for comments from the public.

Jennifer Jilg, Kay Helling, Amanda Darby Davis, Siri (last name unknown), Michael Darby and another Angels Camp citizen voiced their concerns and opposed the smoking ordinance.

Public comment was closed.

Council Member Morris said she is against the ordinance and will be voting no to the ban. Mayor Kulm and Council Member Sobon both favor the ordinance. Vice Mayor Folendorf and Council Member Behiel said they would like to wait until they hear comments at the public hearing. Mr. Behiel suggested the meeting location be changed to the Bret Harte High School Theater. The City Administrator said staff will check with the school for availability and if it is not available for the next meeting, they will reserve the next available date.

MOTION by Council Member Sobon, seconded by Mayor Kulm and carried 4-1 with Council Member Morris voting {NO} ADDING CHAPTER 8.26 TO THE CITY OF ANGELS MUNICIPAL CODE REGULATING SMOKING WITHIN THE CITY OF ANGELS WAIVE READING AND SET A PUBLIC HEARING FOR OCTOBER 18, 2016.

3. **ADOPT A RESOLUTION APPROVING ABATEMENT COST FOR MITIGATING FIRE HAZARDS/PUBLIC NUISANCE ON ONE (1) CITY PARCEL**

MOTION by Council Member Morris, seconded by Vice Mayor Folendorf and carried 5-0 ADOPTING RESOLUTION NO. 16-36. A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE COSTS TO ABATE A PUBLIC NUISANCE ON CALAVERAS COUNTY ASSESSOR PARCEL NUMBER 058-080-007 LOCATED AT 763 GRINDING ROCK ROAD AND DIRECTING A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT AND LIEN UPON THE PARCEL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$723.80
