1. **PUBLIC HEARING: ADOPT ORDINANCE NO. 478. AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 8.26 OF THE CITY OF ANGELS MUNICIPAL CODE REGULATING SMOKING WITHIN THE CITY OF ANGELS**

Mayor Kulm suggested continuing this item to the first Council meeting in November since this was controversial and there were only four members of the Council present. He asked the public for their opinion in postponing the meeting to a later date.

**Michael Darby, James Parrish, Kristi Reeseman, Linda Cross, Shirley Powell, Dr. Dean Kelaita, Amanda Darby-Davis, Celeste Leshar, Mike Blankenberg (?), Kimberly McCarthy, Jason Conrado, Veronica Matildi, Debbie Ponte, Joanne Manesajian, and John Phipps all spoke in favor of continuing the item to a later date.** There were suggestions of publicizing as much as possible before the meeting and several requests that the meeting be postponed until after the first of the year.

MOTION by Vice Mayor Folendorf, seconded by Council Member Behiel and carried 4-0 APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR APPROVAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 478. AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 8.26 TO THE CITY OF ANGELS MUNICIPAL CODE REGULATING SMOKING WITHIN THE CITY OF ANGELS.

The City Administrator pointed out that the date of the meeting is subject to availability of a venue. The firehouse cannot hold the amount of attendees. Staff has been informed by the High School that the theater is not available the entire month of December and may only be available the first meeting in November. There is no other location that can accommodate a large crowd.

MOTION by Council Member Behiel, seconded by Council Member Kulm and carried 4-0 APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF THE MEETING TO JANUARY 17, 2017 AT BRET HARTE HIGH SCHOOL THEATER.

The City Attorney explained that since the meeting was agenzied the public are allowed to speak on the subject. John Broeder, Finnigan Lane said he has comments but will wait until the meeting in January to voice them. He suggested others do the same.
