**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ANGELS CITY COUNCIL RATIFYING THE CITY
ADMINISTRATOR PROCLAMATION OF EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 8630 and the City of Angels Emergency Operations Plan empowers the City Administrator to proclaim a local emergency if the City Council is not in session, subject to ratification by the City Council with seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, conditions or threatened conditions caused by an atmospheric river system bringing damaging winds, substantial precipitation, and flooding within the City; and

WHEREAS, on December 29, 2022, the City Administrator proclaimed the existence of a local emergency in the City based on conditions or threatened conditions caused by the storm; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 8630 generally required the City Council to review the need for continuing the local emergency at least once every sixty (60) days; and

WHEREAS, the City Council does hereby find that conditions or threatened conditions caused by the Winter Storm 2022 did warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency in the City, and that the Winter Storm continues to present conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Angels City Council as follows:

1. Pursuant to Government Code Section 8630, the Proclamation of Existence of a Local Emergency issued by the City Administrator on December 29, 2022, is hereby ratified.
2. The City may request any available funding from the California Disaster Assistance Act (CDAA) and Federal Stafford Act; other recovery assistance programs such as but not limited to General Assistance, Cal Fresh, CalWORKs, Senior Disable Adults, Woman, Infant, and Children Supplemental Nutrition Program, Crisis Counseling, Disaster Unemployment Assistance, and Legal Services; Insurance and Rebuilding Assistance. Available assistance from Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA), includes the Individuals and Household Program (IHP), Small Business Administration (SBA), U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA).
3. The City desires to participate and collaborate with Calaveras County in joint unified command in response to the Winter Storm 2022 event.
4. The local emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist until its termination is proclaimed by the City Council.


